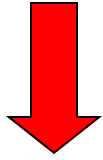

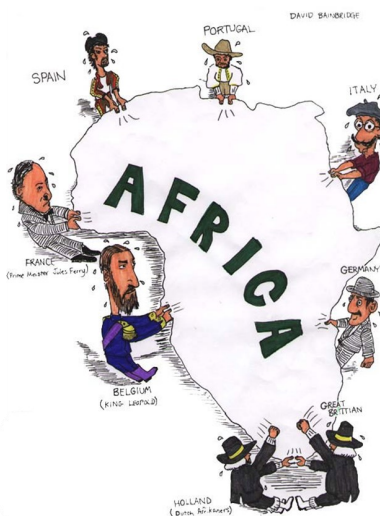


3. a policy of extending your rule over foreign countries

New Imperialism happened because European Countries had a need for raw materials, fuels, and new markets to sell their goods.



European leaders met at the Berlin conference to decide how they were going to split up the land in Africa. They did not invite any African leaders the conference.

The trip from Europe to Asia took more than 3 months. It was a long and dangerous journey. To build a shorter route, Ferdinand de Lesseps built the Suez Canal which linked the Mediterranean Sea to the Red Sea
