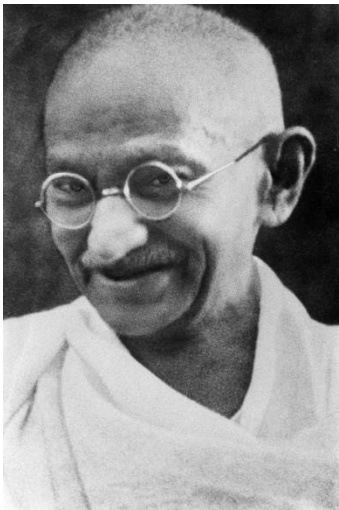
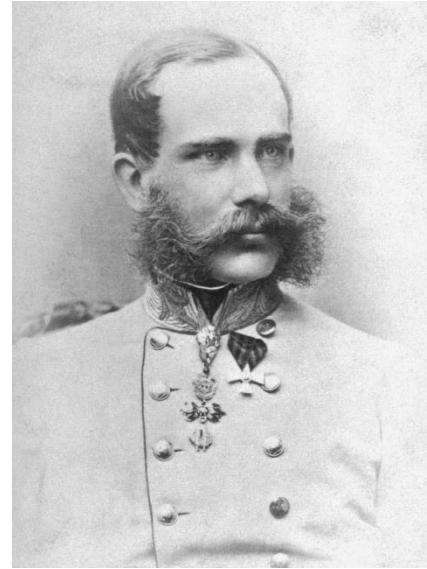


Rising Expectations in Waning Empires
